- what needs to be improved.


How well do we think we are doing

We will offer free school meals to all primary school pupils.


We will introduce a system to improve wellbeing and mental health that helps everyone in school.

We will improve the way we support the mental health of children and young people.



We will work better with families.



We will find out what the best schools are doing and share what they are doing with other schools.


We will give more help to people who are not in work, in school or college or training.

We will work better with social services and other services to help children.



We will make sure school staff are well trained and know what they need to do.



We will support children better as they continue their learning journey.


We will help learners to get better qualifications.

We will ask schools to work together more often.


We will keep giving our staff the chance to have good training.

We will give more chances to people so they can become leaders at different levels in schools and other places.


We will give better support to new and acting headteachers.

We will offer suitable safeguarding training to school governors and staff.


We will develop a guide for pupils about how they should use phones, tablets, and computers safely.

We will look at our plans for how we meet learners' needs to see if we could make them differently.


We will continue our plans to make schools better in the future.

We will work with our partners to make sure we have a good policy to stop serious violence.


We help our young people to stay in education, work, or training.

We will improve how we use the views of our children and young people.



We will make sure more children learn Welsh in our schools.


We will ensure our 'Cymraeg for Kids' project is successful
