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

### What are the types of qualifications?

GCSE's - Exams and controlled assessed tasks these are graded from A\* to G grades (A\* to C is level 2) and (D to G is level 1)

BTEC's - Vocational (Practical) sometimes examined, Some are graded A\*-G others are worth B grades e.g's Music/Sport/Engineering/Public Services


\*It is good to have a range of both types of qualifications
