- You will study 3 subjects plus the welsh baccalaureate at Advanced Level

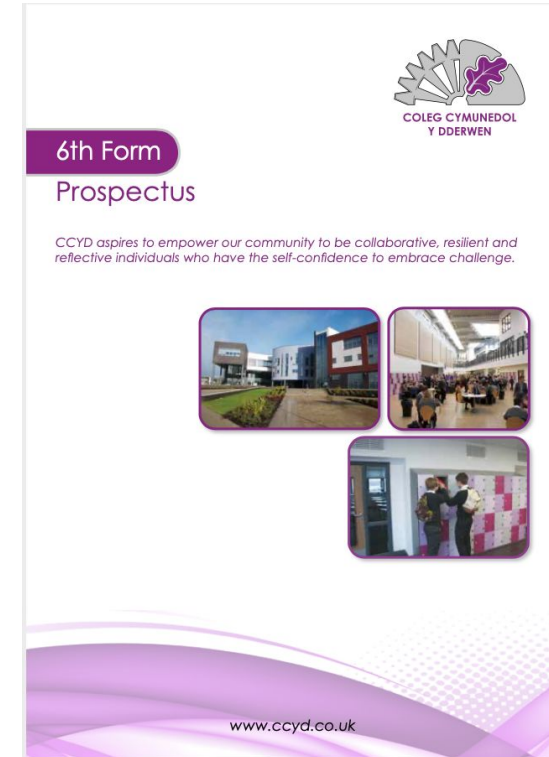
Collaboration - Bridgend schools

Why study in CCYD 6th form (Learners perspective)

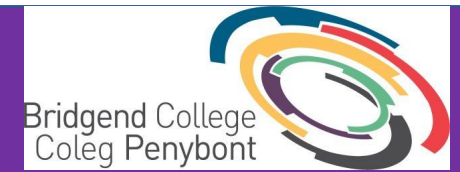
