Dear Parents/Carers,

As Friday looms I would like to inform you of our 'last day' arrangements as follows:

The majority of year 11 learners will be in the hall at 9am to complete their science exam. Learners sitting the exam are expected to wear their school uniform as normal - no decorated shirts or polo tops are allowed to be worn inside the exam hall.

Learners not sitting the exam will attend Maths lesson 1.

During lessons 3 and 4 the whole year group will be taking part in an organised colour-run on the school field where they will run/walk the marked course whilst being gently splattered with powder paint.

To take part in this your child will need the following:

1. Old clothes that are ok to be splattered with paint,
2. Protective eyewear **which will be provided by the school.**

On completion of the colour run, learners will be treated to ice cream - there is no cost for this.

Learners are expected to change back to school uniform following the colour-run as those travelling home on the bus will not be permitted to wear their colour-run clothing on school transport.

After an extended lunch all learners will be gathered in the main hall for our celebration assembly.

At the end of the day Year 11 learners will be clapped out of school by staff - if you would like to watch/take part in this celebration please arrive at the school before 2.45pm.

I feel incredibly lucky to have been gifted your children as my designated year group and when I reflect upon the past 5 years I have so many treasured memories.
