Following the recent autumn meeting of the Governing Body, I would like to remind all parents, carers and learners of our school's uniform policy, which has once again been formally ratified. The uniform policy plays a key role in promoting a sense of unity and pride within our school community.

Further details of our updated policy are available on our website and is attached with this letter along with a copy of the recent letter sent from the Chair of Governors.

In summary our Uniform Expectations are:

- **Tops:** White shirt with tie
- **Bottoms:** Black trousers or skirt
- **Footwear:** Plain black shoes or plain black trainers
- **Outerwear:** School jumper or cardigan [no hoodies]
- **Hair colouring should be of a natural colour**
- **Facial piercings are not allowed**
- **White ankle socks worn over black tights are not allowed**

We kindly ask for your support in ensuring that your child arrives at school each day dressed in accordance with these guidelines. If there are any issues or concerns regarding uniform, please do not hesitate to contact us so we can offer support.
