Continuation in 6th Form - September 2026 for Current Year 12 Learners

Date - Monday 6th July 2026

Dear Parents/Carers and learners (Current Year 12)

As we approach the end of another successful academic year, I would like to provide you with some important information regarding induction day and continuation into year 13

Continuing into year 13

If you are continuing into year 13 we would like you to complete a short google form survey please on or after the year 12/ A level results day on the 13th August. This will go live in your Pastoral Google classroom on the morning of the 13th August. To continue in year 13 you must study at least 2 A level / Level 3 quals alongside the Advanced Skills Baccalaureate Wales which in Wales is mandatory. Should you wish to drop one of your current subjects this would need to be discussed and agreed with Miss Lambert during the induction day. If you did not pass the AS units in the summer in a particular subject then you will not be able to continue in this subject. If this is the case for more than one subject then you will not be permitted to continue your studies in the 6th Form. This includes current progress and assessment in the Advanced Skills Baccalaureate Wales, if you are currently failing in this subject based on work completed so far then you will not be permitted to continue in the 6th form. If you are unsure, speak to your Welsh Baccalaureate Teacher or Miss Lambert.

Year 13 Induction Day

Our **Year 13 Induction Day** will take place on **Thursday 3rd September**. Attendance is compulsory for all learners who intend to continue in 6th Form, and learners should have completed the online re-application form beforehand. Lessons will commence on **Monday 7th September**.

The induction programme will begin at **8:30am** on the 3rd September and learners will be based in the **Activities Hall** throughout the day. Activities will include:

- Information about continuing Sixth Form expectations and opportunities;
- Guest speakers discussing UCAS and Post 18 pathways
